

2013- 2014 Cost of Attendance

The EMCC Financial Aid Office uses budgets that reflect our **average** anticipated student expenses in determining aid eligibility. Student's actual costs may vary according to choice of residence hall, meal plan, personal needs, and academic program. Adjustments to an individual student budget may be possible, based on documentation of the student's additional educationally related costs.

Tuition & Fees	<p>2013-2014 budget amounts are based on a student registering for 30 credit hours for (\$88/credit hour for Maine residents, \$129 for New England Regional (NEHBE) students, and \$172 for non-Maine residents).</p> <p>Actual tuition and fees are based on each individual student's actual number of credit hours each term.</p>
Room & Board	<p>Amount represents the student's cost for a double room on campus with a 7-day meal plan. The student's actual cost may be lower, based on their selection of residence hall and 5 or 7 day meal plan. Students living in a campus residence hall are billed on a semester basis for their room and meal plan. The room and board figure in the cost of attendance is used for students living on campus or an off campus apartment/home.</p>
Books & Supplies	<p>Represents student's cost for textbooks, notebooks, pens and other miscellaneous school supplies. Actual costs may vary. Adjustments may be made to a student's budget to reflect their estimated cost of tools for their academic program.</p>
Travel	<p>Average daily commuting costs for students living off campus <u>or</u> average anticipated expense for on-campus resident student to go home during school breaks.</p>
Miscellaneous	<p>This category includes laundry, clothing, routine medical and other personal expenses. Actual costs vary depending on each student's needs and lifestyle.</p>
