

HOPE MILLIKEN MCNALLY SCHOLARSHIP

Former Ellsworth resident, Hope Milliken McNally created a scholarship program for graduates of Ellsworth High School who attend Eastern Maine Community College. Scholarships are awarded on a **first come, first serve basis**. **Effective 2010-2011 Academic Year scholarship award is \$800/year for full time and \$400/part time students.**

Scholarship Criteria:

1. Ellsworth High School Graduate.
2. Accepted into a degree, diploma, or certificate program at EMCC.
3. Enrolled at least half-time (six credit hours).
4. Maintained a 2.5 grade point average for EACH SEMESTER of enrollment. The semester grade point average does not apply to those attending their first semester at the college.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Complete:

- Hope Milliken McNally Scholarship Application
- Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), **prior to June 1st (required)**
- EMCC Data Confirmation Form (required; this will be mailed to you once we have your FAFSA)

INFORMATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS

AWARDING AND DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS

- Scholarship is not offered until student is admitted to the college.
- Applicants are awarded based on the date their scholarship application is received at EMCC.
- If funds available for the award year are expended, remaining eligible applicants are placed on a wait list and awarded, when funds become available.
- If an over-award of financial aid occurs due to student's receipt of additional grants, Hope Milliken McNally funds are retracted prior to disbursement of other grant assistance.

ACADEMIC AND ADMINISTRATION REQUIREMENTS:

- ✓ Recipient must achieve a 2.5 GRADE POINT AVERAGE EACH SEMESTER to continue receipt of funds (CUMULATIVE GPA IS NOT CONSIDERED)
- ✓ Recipient must be continuously enrolled each term to receive funds
- ✓ Recipient will continue to receive funds until completion of **first academic credential** (degree, diploma or certificate)
- ✓ Recipient must re- apply for the scholarship if:
 - ◆ If changing academic program **OR**
 - ◆ Returning from a period of non-enrollment for a second or subsequent academic program

IF EITHER CASE:

- **Award of scholarship funds is based on availability after new high school graduates and continuing EMCC students have been awarded.**
- ✓ Recipient with an approved **Leave of Absence** status is eligible for reinstatement of the scholarship, if funds are available
 - Recipient with an approved Leave of Absence status must complete an updated Scholarship application within 30 days of the start of semester.

APPEAL PROCESS

Any appeal by a student recipient must be made in writing and submitted to the Student Aid Office.
