

Eastern Maine Community College has designed the **Fresh Start Scholarship** to provide an opportunity for Maine citizens to begin their college education at a **significantly reduced cost**.

- EMCC's Fresh Start Scholarship pays for 100% of tuition and fees
- Student may take up to six credits per year, three each in two semesters.
- Student is responsible for purchasing required books and course materials as well as transportation to and from class

**Eligibility Criteria**

- Graduate of from high school prior to 2007, or
- Left high school prior to 2007 and completed an adult diploma or GED.
- No prior or current college attendance.
- Enroll in credit course offered by EMCC.

**Restrictions:**

- registration for course is subject to space availability;
- scholarship funds are limited to payment for an EMCC general education (non-technology) courses;
- enroll in a three credit class (typically one class) during the fall or spring semesters;
- course must be taught on site at the EMCC Campus or an EMCC College Center (online classes are not available for this waiver).
- student must complete placement testing to assure appropriate course placement;
