

Eastern Maine Community College is looking for an experience Phlebotomy Instructor to teach its Introduction to Phlebotomy course in conjunctions with Affiliated Labs of Bangor. The course is held in the spring and fall semesters. The spring course starts about mid-March and the fall semester course starts in early September.

The course meets for a total of 56 hours (40 classroom, 16 clinical). Classes are held on Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 6-8pm for 10 weeks. Clinicals are administered by Affiliated Lab staff. The maximum class size is 20 students chosen after an interview and application process.

Qualifications:

Instructor should be certified (ASCP preferred), have experience in the field (5 years with 2-3 in a hospital setting), have some teaching experience, and have taken a formal course in phlebotomy. An instructor should also have the capability to choose a qualified lab assistant to assist during the practical phase of the course.

This position would be hired directly through EMCC's Business & Industry department on a contractual hourly basis.
