- Partner with a cooperating Maine educator on the creation of a Veteran's Memorial

- Serve as a volunteer for the Cole Land Transportation Museum (20 hours)
- Research an artifact, individual, family or business associated with an artifact and submit a research document of 8 pages that can be added to our records
