



CNA Instructor Requirements

Eastern Maine Community College is seeking a new instructor to teach CNA courses at Penobscot Job Corps.

The instructor will teach five weeks of classroom/lab training, Mon thru Fri, contact hours 8am-3pm, followed by four weeks of clinical training, Mon thru Fri, 6am-2pm. The courses are on-going and position is year-round. Candidates should have strong communication and organizational skills. Requirements include a current Maine RN License; two years of RN experience; one year RN experience in the “provision of long-term care facility services” (long term care can be part of the two year work experience); and either a state approved “Train the Trainer” course, or coursework in teaching adults, or experience supervising nurse aids.
