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EDB101—Introduction to Career and Technical Education

The above courses are hybrid courses. Generally, each course meets 3-4 times with additional work and assignments to be completed using an online format. Generally the E-learning system is used for online course content delivery and submission of assignments.

Delivery of above courses use the TANBERG system and is offered at a maximum of four CTE sites including the host site where the instructor will be. The sites are determined once enrollment has been completed. Every effort is made to reduce travel time and cost to students, but some travel to the nearest site may be required.
