

The purpose of this agreement is to establish STAT Transfer, a seamless transfer process between the University of Maine at Augusta (UMA) and Eastern Maine Community College (EMCC). Through STAT transfer, EMCC students - upon completion of an Associate Degree in Nursing from EMCC - are guaranteed admission with junior standing to the University of Maine at Augusta's RN-BSN Program.

Under this agreement, a EMCC student: (1) must be enrolled in an Associate of Science degree in Nursing program; and (2) be on track to achieve a GPA of 2.5 or higher. Upon joining the RN-BSN program, students will have the benefits of receiving early advising, a streamlined application process with no University application fee, and advanced course registration with continuing students.

This agreement shall be effective for five years, upon which time it will be reviewed and revised as appropriate.
