**Minimum Qualifications:** Bachelor's degree in computer technology, digital media, educational technology, communications-media or related field. 2-4 years of experience in online course development and design. Familiarity with instructional design theory and demonstrated abilities and understanding of technology and software that can assist faculty in preparing their course for delivery.

Administrative experience in higher education.
