START A NEW CAREER IN THE MEDICAL FIELD!

A Nursing Assistant is an individual who provides basic care under the supervision of a Registered Professional Nurse. This course consists of a combination of classes in theory, laboratory, and clinical learning experiences. You will be given the opportunity to acquire Knowledge, Skills, and attitudes necessary to function safely in a clinical setting. Students who successfully complete the course and the State Board Examination will receive a State of Maine Certification for Basic Nursing Assistant. This program consists of 110 hours of classroom and 30 hours of lab instruction, and 80 hours of clinical time. Candidates must present either a high school diploma, or HISET/GED.
