Admission requirements of GPA 2.5

Transfer up to 90 applicable credits toward the total of 120 credits needed for BSN

Award block transfer nursing credits or equivalents at ADN/diploma level up to 39 credits

Depending upon credit allocation, additional elective credits may be required to meet 120 minimum credits for degree completion.

***Only electives applicable to the BS Nursing degree have been listed as options**

Candidates for a Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing (RN to BSN Track) are required to complete a minimum of 120 semester hours. Transfer students must complete a minimum of thirty (30) credit hours at Husson University and at least fifteen (15) credits must be earned in Husson Nursing courses.
