### TRIO Agreement and Application Certification

- I understand that the goal of the TRIO program is to retain and graduate eligible EMCC students. I further understand that being in Student Support Services is a privilege. I understand that:
  - 1) I will be assigned a TRIO Advisor
  - 2) I may be assigned a Peer Mentor
  - 3) I may receive tutoring, study skills help, academic advising, financial aid assistance, peer support, transfer advising, and other TRIO services while I am an active participant in the program.
- To be considered an active participant, I understand I am required to:
  - 1) Meet with a TRIO staff member at least once per month (academic year only)
  - 2) Access a minimum of three other TRIO services per semester. These include: tutoring, workshops, college visits, cultural events, community service projects and peer mentoring.
- If I fail to meet the requirements for participation, I can be dropped from the program.
- If my GPA drops below a 2.0, I agree to meet with my TRIO advisor bi-weekly to develop and follow through with an Academic Support Plan (ASP) to improve my academic standing.
- I understand that at some time my photograph may be taken, either in a group or individually, by the TRIO program and/or Eastern Maine Community College for promotional purposes without compensation. I give my permission for my photograph to be used for this purpose.
- I authorize EMCC TRIO SSS to obtain, copy, review, and discuss records including high school transcripts, course registration for each semester, enrollment verification, academic progress reports, financial aid records, and standardized test scores. I also understand that spaces in available in TRIO SSS are limited and students will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis within eligible categories.

## TRIO Student Support Services at EMCC

Are you planning to graduate from EMCC or transfer to a 4-year college and want the support that will help you succeed? If so, you need to know about TRIO Student Support Services.

#### What is TRIO Student Support Services (SSS)?

TRIO Student Support Services (SSS) is funded by the Department of Education to help students be successful in college and beyond. TRIO SSS provides opportunities for academic development and serves to motivate students towards the successful completion of their postsecondary education. The goal of TRIO SSS is to increase college retention and graduation rates of participants.

#### What free services does TRIO SSS offer at EMCC?

- Walk-in advising with advisors who are specifically dedicated to working with TRIO SSS students
- Exclusive access to tutors who will work with your schedule
- Access to a peer mentor who will monitor your progress and offer assistance whenever needed
- Assistance with class registration to keep you on track to meet your educational goals
- Workshops and activities to enhance personal development and academic progress
- Career counseling
- Help with completing the FAFSA, understanding the financial aid process, and scholarship searches
- Referrals to staff, faculty, and other professionals to help you with a variety of needs
- Opportunity to participate in a summer bridge program
- Annual cultural experience trip! (In the past we have visited Boston and gone whale watching in Bar Harbor)
- Visits to regional 4-year colleges for students interested in transferring after graduating from EMCC
- End-of-the year banquet to celebrate our graduates and outstanding TRIO students

### Who is eligible for TRIO SSS?

TRIO eligibility is based on few important factors:

- Students must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents
- Students must be in need of and able to benefit from academic support
- Students must also meet at least one of the following criteria:
  - o Be a first-generation college student, meaning neither of your parents or guardians graduated from a four-year college
  - o Have financial need, defined as being Pell Grant eligible and meeting certain government guidelines for taxable income, or
  - o Have a documented physical, medical, psychological or learning disability
