

LIVE-IN INTERNSHIP COORDINATOR

Title of Position: Live-In Internship Coordinator (Contracted position)

Responsibilities:

- Serve as an adjunct instructor for the FIR 127 course each semester
- Recruitment and retention of EMCC students for the Live-In Internship
- Maintaining relationships with current host site locations
- Monitor and advise live-in students on their overall academic progress
- Evaluating and acquiring new host site locations
- Serve as student advisor and mentor for students currently enrolled in the Live-In Internship program
- Be available in an "on-call" setting at all times while internship students are in service at host locations during the school year
- Ensure that all interns have adequate supervision while operating at their respective host locations.
- Periodically check in on Live-In students' progress by making site visit
- Provides administrative support to the Fire Science Department Chair as needed
- Facilitate the yearly Live-In draft process and maintain an active list of candidates
- Maintaining and developing documentation relating to live-in Internship
- Assist in course development in relation to the Live-In Internship Program
- Serve as a liaison with the Penobscot County Fire Chiefs' Association and a program coordinator for the yearly Penobscot County Fire Academy.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Associates degree in Fire Science Technology
- Current fire department membership
- Effective communication skills
- Demonstrated experience as a direct supervisor in emergency services

Preferred Qualification:

- 5 or more years of direct supervisor experience in emergency services
- Currently serving as a EMCC Live-In Internship host site coordinator
