Arc of Engagement & Commitment

All expenses are funded by Maine DOE
Program requires commitment for one full academic year



Phase 1: Boot Camp

- Intensive 3-credit course
- Completed in 10 days
 - Cohort 1 & 2: August 20 – August 30
 - Cohort 3 & 4: September 17 – September 27
- Meet daily from 4:00 – 6:00 via Zoom (except weekends)
- Homework each day, evening and weekend in Brightspace
- Complete DOE fingerprinting requirements



Phase 2: Community of Practice

- Class meetings every other week on a consistent night from 4:00 – 6:00 via Zoom from October – June
- Online assignments completed to earn digital badges – assignments are connected directly to classroom work hours
 - Developmentally Appropriate Practice: October
 - Inclusive Practices: November
 - Effective Observation: December and January
 - Positive Guidance: February
 - Instructional Strategies: March and April
 - Educational Partnership: May



Phase 3: Teaching Apprenticeship

- Complete at least 315 hours of paid work in a public-school classroom setting from October – June
- Identify a mentor who will be your journey guide and evaluate you two times over the academic year
- Implement assignments completed in Community of Practice
- Complete a Personalized Learning Plan



Learning Facilitator Micro-Credential

- Eligible for Ed Tech III authorization
- 6 additional college credits applied to transcript
