## **PARAMEDIC**

WHAT: One-term course

WHEN: 5:30 - 8:30 PM Monday and Wednesday nights, with 4 Saturday classes (2/12, 3/5, 3/19, and 4/9) that meet 8:30 AM - 5:00 PM at EMCC. Additional program location in Orono, Tuesday and Thursday nights 1/18 - 5/13 from 6:00 - 9:00 PM with select Saturdays (2/5, 3/5, 4/16, 5/7) from 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM

**WHO**: Anyone who is interested in becoming an EMT

**OUTCOMES**: Eligible to take the NREMT EMT exam to be a licensed EMT

**REGISTER**: Visit www.emcc.edu/register to enroll in EMS123 (Basic). Must follow EMCC requirements (vaccinations, background check, etc.) **WHAT**: A program of study that includes 5 core courses delivered over two terms.

**WHEN**: Spring and Fall Terms, Tues. 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM with alternating Wed. 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM.

**WHO**: Anyone who is interested in becoming an Advanced EMT who is currently licensed at the EMT level.

**OUTCOMES**: Eligible to take the NREMT AEMT exam to be a licensed AEMT

APPLY: Learners must apply for admission to the EMS certificate program, hold a current EMT license, & follow EMCC requirements (vaccinations, background check, etc)

**WHAT**: A program of study that includes 8 core courses delivered over three terms.

**WHEN**: Thursdays 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM with alternating Wednesdays 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM.

**WHO**: Anyone who is interested in becoming a Paramedic who is currently licensed at the AEMT level.

**OUTCOMES**: Eligible to take the NREMT Paramedic exam to be a licensed Paramedic

**APPLY:** Learners must apply for admission to the EMS associate degree program, hold a current AEMT license, and follow EMCC requirements (vaccinations, background check, etc)
