Upon completion of the program, graduates will obtain an associate in science degree and are eligible to take the NCLEX Registered Nurse (RN) licensure examination.



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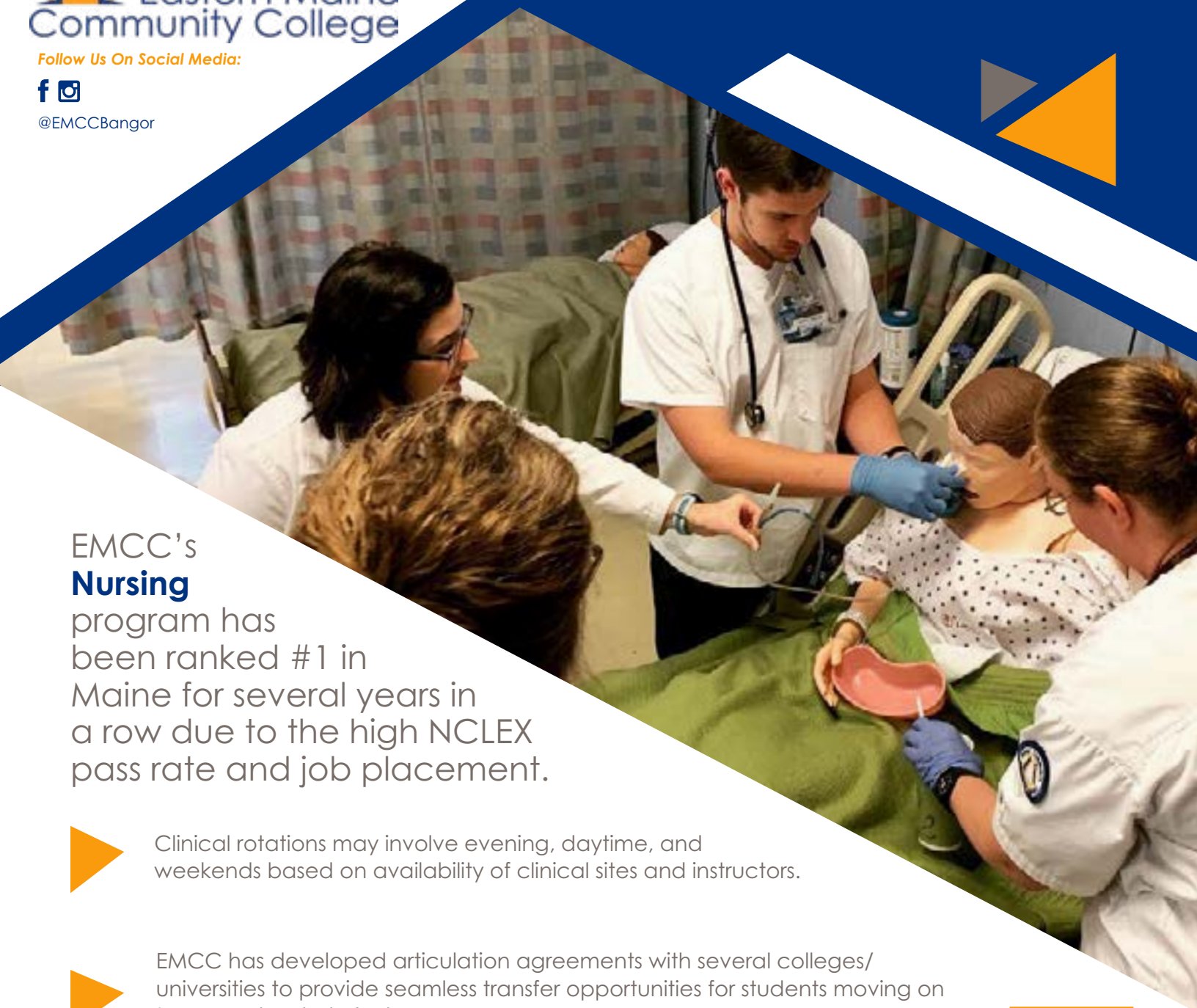
EMCC's **Nursing** program has been ranked #1 in Maine for several years in a row due to the high NCLEX pass rate and job placement.

Clinical rotations may involve evening, daytime, and weekends based on availability of clinical sites and instructors.

EMCC has developed articulation agreements with several colleges/universities to provide seamless transfer opportunities for students moving on to earn a bachelor's degree.

Did you know that EMCC has TWO residence halls on campus?

Built in 2007, Kineo Hall houses students in "blocks" (two double-occupancy rooms with four people of the same gender) or triple-occupancy rooms. Each is individually climate controlled and shares a common bathroom, with double sinks, a shower and a toilet stall.

Acadia Hall houses students in corridor-style double or triple occupancy rooms.

Rooms range from \$1,850 - \$2,250 per semester.
