Responsibilities: EMCC is looking to fill a full-time Fine Woodworking and Cabinetmaking instructor position to begin **August 22, 2022**. The chosen candidate will be a learner-focused, precision minded individual with an ability to develop curriculum that includes employability essentials and technical content to meet current industry practices. This position requires a strong cabinetmaking and woodworking background with milling, assembly, hand tool, power tool, and shop machinery (including CNC) experience. The ideal candidate will have leadership experience and exceptional communication skills and will teach the equivalent of a full-load of courses in basic and intermediate woodworking, advise students and serve on college committees. Additional job responsibilities include maintenance of equipment and advanced material and supply planning.

Minimum Qualifications Associate's degree in woodworking, cabinetmaking or construction or 5-7 years of experience in the field.

Preferred Qualifications: Bachelor's degree. Ability to support at-risk students. Program and curriculum development skills. Collaborative, creative and passionate about teaching and learning.
