**Responsibilities:** The Resident Director (RD) serves as a **primary live-in administrator** of a residence hall. He/she shall focus on providing a clean, safe and secure environment. The RD will work with resident assistants and other student leaders to develop a campus community promoting holistic wellness (including civic engagement, student development, fitness and well-being).

- Assist with Resident Assistant and Student Leadership training
- Plan and conduct weekly staff meetings
- Provide on-going supervision, support and evaluation to the RA staff and student leaders
- Plan and implement social, educational and wellness programs
- Communicate, interpret and enforce College and residence hall policies and procedures
- Address disciplinary issues while empowering students to take responsibility for their actions and decisions
- Work cooperatively with Safety & Security, Facilities Maintenance and other college departments in response to day-to-day functions

**Minimum Qualifications:** Bachelor's Degree and experience with residential living. Ability to communicate effectively with all types of people. Microsoft Office proficient.
