

Health Sciences Reasoning Test Nursing Candidate Instructions

How to Schedule

- Click on the link below and choose a date/time from the available options.
 Maximum of 15 seats are available for each date. Please allow up to four (4) hours for your visit.
- To cancel/reschedule, go back to Sign-up Genius and make the adjustment. (Cancel first date, then reschedule a new date.) For questions or assistance with scheduling a date, email admissions@emcc.edu.
- Candidates are permitted to take the assessment once.
- At this time, there is no option to complete the test and info session remotely.
- Candidates who require accommodations for the assessment due to a documented disability are urged to contact access@emcc.edu to make that request and receive an approval in writing prior to scheduling a date for the exam and info session.

SIGN-UP GENIUS HSRT EXAM and INFO SESSION DATES

How to **Prepare**

- The sections of the assessment that will be administered are HSRT-AD and CCTDI.
- The assessment is timed. HSRT-AD consists of 50 minutes to answer 35 multiple choice questions. CCTDI consists of 30 minutes to answer 75 agree/disagree questions.
- After the assessment, the info session with faculty is expected to last up to one and a half (1 1/2) additional hours.
- More information about these assessments and how to study for them is provided in the handouts.

On The Day Of Your Visit

- Arrive AT LEAST 30 minutes prior to the start of the assessments. Late arrivals may be asked to reschedule.
- The combined cost of the assessments is \$35, payable on the day of the appointment via exact cash amount or check (payable to EMCC); credit/debit cards will not be accepted.
- Photo ID required.
- No personal belongings are needed or permitted to be in possession of the examinee during the assessments.
- Candidates who cannot show proof of identity and/or do not supply the fee will not be permitted to take the assessments.

Where to Go

- Report to Room 310, on the third floor of Katahdin Hall.
- Parking is available in Parking Lot-B. (See map below. Katahdin Hall is building #2. Solid black arrow on map shows preferred entrance to building.)
- While the assessments will be given in Katahdin Hall, the info session with faculty will be held in Maine Hall. A staff member will escort you to the appropriate area upon completion of the assessments. Wear appropriate clothing for a short walk outside!

Cancellation Policy

- •When the assessment/info session is cancelled due to expected inclement weather or unavoidable circumstance, scheduled candidates will be notified at least 24 hours in advance via the email and/or phone number on file.
- •When the EMCC campus is closed due to inclement weather, the assessment/info session will be cancelled. Candidates are asked to reschedule via SignUp Genius.
- •If EMCC closes early while assessments are underway, they will continue as long as it's safe to do so.
- •It is up to the candidate's discretion to determine if they can safely make it to and from campus in the instance where the assessment and info session will proceed as scheduled and inclement weather is expected.
