

Medical Radiography Clinical Adjunct Faculty

Position Description: This adjunct faculty position requires an individual with experience in clinical student supervision and evaluation, and with current knowledge of radiographic procedures. This position requires an individual with recent (minimum 5 years) experience as a radiographer since this individual will spend much of their time at the clinical internship sites assisting students in the performance of examinations, conducting student evaluations, verifying the completion of semester clinical objectives, and performing competency testing. The total clinical time involved is approximately 8 - 16 hours weekly. This individual will act as a liaison between the college and the clinical sites and is expected to communicate with the other program faculty for the purpose of continuous program improvement.

Position Qualifications:

- Certified with American Registry in Radiologic Technology (ARRT certification must be current and, at minimum, include the category of radiography)
- Licensed with State of Maine (in the category of Radiography)
- Equivalent of minimum of 5 years of recent experience as a radiographer
- Knowledgeable in instruction and evaluation
- Demonstrated strong interest in radiography education
- Evidence of ability to provide students with the knowledge and skills required of a radiographer
- Desire and ability to motivate students
