

## TOURNAMENT RULES

## Points and Scoring

- For every round, teams will have point values between one and five (1-5) to allocate towards a question. Each point value must be used and cannot be used more than once. Correct answers will win teams the points they allocated for the questions. For example, if a team designated " 3 " points to the question on sports and answered it correctly, the team would be awarded those 3 points. There are no points deducted for incorrect answers.
- Each team will receive an official scorecard for every round where they will write their answers AND chosen point value. Questions are NOT multiple choice. The MC will spend $20-30$ seconds on each question before moving on to the next one. Teams will submit their scorecards to a designated score keeper at the end of each round. Teams cannot change their answers or point allocations once they have submitted their scorecard.
- Scores will be displayed after the third round. Trivia question disputes will be addressed during the intermission. The Trivia Master makes the final decision and all decisions are final.
- The team with the most points at the end of the last round is the winner. In the event of a tie, or multiple ties, we will enter sudden death rounds until a winner emerges.


## Zero Tolerance for Cheating

- No use of mobile devices and technology.
- No consulting with audience members.
- Any team caught cheating will be disqualified for that round. If a team is caught cheating a second time, they will be asked to leave the tournament.


## Prize and Awards

- The winning team will be awarded $\$ 500$. The prize money will be sent in the form of a check, after the event, to the person of the team's choosing.
- Each individual on the team will also receive a trophy.
