### Transfer Articulation Agreement for Baccalaureate Degree between Eastern Maine Community College and University of Maine Presque Isle

#### **Statement of Purpose**

Eastern Maine Community College (EMCC) and University of Maine Presque Isle have entered into this transfer articulation agreement. The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate student academic transfer and provide a smooth transition from a two-year community college to University of Maine Presque Isle. This agreement shall describe the required program of study at EMCC and the specific course equivalencies for the University of Maine Presque Isle Baccalaureate Degree Program indicated.

#### Terms and Conditions of Academic Credit Transfer

To: University of Maine Presque Isle Elementary Education BS - Early Childhood Education concentration From: Eastern Maine Community College Early Childhood degree

The evaluation and transfer of earned college credits shall be in compliance with state and federal education policies and institutional and academic program accreditation standards pertaining to undergraduate academic transfer. Current students and graduates who have earned the advanced certificate in Early Childhood Education degrees from Eastern Maine Community College shall be eligible for credit evaluation under the terms of this agreement.

Transfer students will be accorded the same standards and criteria for admission to a major degree sequence as University of Maine Presque Isle students. All applications accepted to University of Maine Presque Isle Baccalaureate programs must fulfill the graduation requirements of the granting institution as identified in the following pages.

#### **Articulation Implementation and Agreement Review**

The Chief Academic Officer designee of EMCC and University of Maine Presque Isle shall be responsible for implementing this agreement, for identifying and incorporating any changes into subsequent agreements and for conducting a periodic review of this agreement.
