### Information for Student Applicants

#### **SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA:**

1. Ellsworth High School Graduate, and
2. Admitted to a Degree or Certificate Program at EMCC, and
3. Enroll at least half-time (six credit hours) each semester, and

#### **AWARDING AND DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS**

- Scholarships are not offered until students are admitted to college.
- Awards first come, first serve, based on the date their scholarship application is received by EMCC.
- Annual Scholarship Amount: \$1500 (\$750 per semester)
- Awards are made in Fall and Spring Semesters (no funds are available for summer classes).
- If an over-award of financial aid occurs due to student's receipt of additional grants, Hope Milliken McNally funds are retracted prior to disbursement of other grant assistance.

#### **ACADEMIC AND ADMINISTRATION REQUIREMENTS:**

- ✓ Recipients must earn a 2.0 Grade Point Average (GPA) each semester.
- ✓ Recipient receives scholarship until completion of their **first academic credential** (Degree or Certificate).
- ✓ Recipients only need to re-apply for the scholarship if they take a leave of absence or change their academic program.

#### **APPEAL PROCESS**

Student appeal must be made in writing and submitted to the Student Aid Office for review by the Director of Student Aid.
